



Funding Rebellion

The truth of the matter is that Jesus demands change; change in how we think and change in how we steward the money He has given to us. If we choose not to be good stewards, He will take what we have and give it to another. That, my friend, is basic Bible.

If we want revival we need to stop funding the local terrorist organization that is operated by Hell that has a form of godliness but denies the power of God.
